

City of Brighton Public Information Meeting Notice

Brighton City Manager Dana Foster will be conducting a public information and public input meeting on Community Improvement Needs in the City of Brighton. The meeting will be conducted on Monday, January 30, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. at the Brighton District Library's A/B Meeting Room located at 100 Library Drive, Brighton, Michigan 48116.

The City Manager will give a brief overview of Community and Public Improvement needs that a Citizens Advisory Task Force identified in a report to the Brighton City Council in the Spring of 2011. The City Manager's presentation will also contain information about a possible community and public improvements bond issue proposal for the City's voters to consider in the November of 2012 election that would be Millage-Neutral (no property tax increase) if approved by the voters. After the informational presentation, the City Manager will be asking for inputs from meeting attendees regarding what the priorities should be for Community and Public Improvements in Brighton. The City Manager will then report the audience inputs and suggestions to the Brighton City Council to consider with regards to whether or not a Millage-Neutral Bond Issue should be placed on a November, 2012 ballot for city voters and to help the City Council decide what should be on a list of proposed Community and Public Improvements projects for such a possible Bond Issue election. The Brighton City Council has to make a decision by or before August 1, 2012 with regards to whether there should or should not be a Millage-Neutral bond issue election for city voters in November of 2012.
