SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID FOR CURED IN PLACE PIPE

ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

- The 2107 Sanitary Sewer Lining Bid was put out on 11/09/17
- This bid was to line approximately 650 feet of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipe on Rickett Road.
- We received 3 bids (see Bid Tabulation below).
- Insituform Technologies, USA was the lowest responsive bidder at \$24,500
- This award is in lieu of the related City Council discussion at the October 19th City Council meeting.
- After additional review by staff, it was determined to reduce the project scope to address the most urgent needs, and issue a more comprehensive multi-year bid following the complete review of all sewer video.
- Funding for this project is in the Utilities budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve of the award of bid for Cured in Place Pipe to Insituform Technologies, USA in the amount of \$24,500.
