MINUTES OF THE STUDY SESSION OF THE BRIGHTON CITY COUNCIL HELD ON AUGUST 2, 2018

STUDY SESSION

Mayor Muzzin called the Study Session to order at 6:30 p.m.

Present were Mayor Muzzin, Councilmembers: Bohn, Emaus, Gardner, Pettengill, Pipoly, and Tobbe. Staff: City Manager Nate Geinzer, City Clerk Tara Brown, DPW Director Marcel Goch, Utilities Director Tim Krugh, Community Development Manager Mike Caruso, Assistant to the City Manager/DDA Coordinator Brandon Skopek, Chief of Police Rob Bradford, Finance Director Gretchen Gomolka, and Attorney Paul Burns. There were 15 persons in the audience.

CALL TO PUBLIC

Mayor Muzzin opened the Call to the Public at 6:30 p.m. with no response.

DISCUSSION OF ORDINANCE UPDATES

Community Development Manager Mike Caruso presented several ordinance updates including setbacks for accessory structures, collection bins for donations, and noise issues during early morning garbage collection. Council was in favor of a five-foot setback for accessory structures, collection bin regulations, and asked DPW Director Marcel Goch and Mr. Caruso to look into garbage collection uniformity throughout commercial areas utilizing one service provider.

Motion by Councilmember Emaus, seconded by Councilmember Pettengill to amend the agenda to add item 4a. Second Street Updates. **The motion carried unanimously.**

Second Street Updates

Due to the nature and time frame of the Second Street Project, City contractors recommended to Mr. Goch and Utilities Director Krugh to close Second Street to through traffic in an effort to expedite construction. Pending approval by the Brighton Area Fire Department and the City of Brighton Police Department, Second Street will close to through traffic.
