SUBJECT: REQUEST TO APPROVE THE REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED DRIVEWAY AND PARKING LOT LIGHTS AT THE PD/DPS COMPLEX.

PURCHASE REQUEST REVIEW

DRIVEWAY LIGHT BOLLARDS

- All ten driveway light bollards for the PD/DPS have been slowly breaking due to their age of 25 years and are not energy efficient.
- In order to change the bulbs, the bollard sleeve must be removed; however, the sleeves are rusted at the base and cannot be re-secured. The inability to secure the sleeve is creating a safety hazard as they are falling over and exposing wires.
- Several lights bollards were poorly placed in the original design causing them to be struck by snow plows or in the path of where the snow is pushed. These will be moved or eliminated.

OVERHEAD LIGHT POLES

- All ten current driveway bollards will be replaced with four overhead L.E.D. light poles evenly spaced.
- PD has (2) light poles and DPW has (1) light pole that have not been replaced from the original installation 25 years ago and are rusted at the base and in need of replacement.
- PD will add (1) overhead light pole in the Northeast corner of the front parking lot which will illuminate the side walk that goes alongside the PD where students walk to school.

EQUIPMENT REQUESTED

- Eight overhead L.E.D. light poles that match previously replaced poles.
- All related equipment for installation has been outlined in the quote.

BUDGET

- Both DPS and PD budgeted \$10,000 each for this project.
- Bray Electric total estimate, including materials, is \$19,915.79.

COMPETITIVE BID

- Bray Electric is the City's electrical contractor and was previously obtained through a competitive bid process.

RECOMMENDATION

- Approve Bray Electric to replace damaged driveway and parking lot lights at the PD/DPS in the amount of \$19,915.79.

SUBJECT: TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER (TCO) 176 ON N. 1st STREET BETWEEN W. MAIN STREET AND CHESTNUT STREET

ISSUE:

- Statutorily (MCL 257.627), N First St. falls under the definition of a residential street with a state set speed limit of 25 MPH.
 - *(d) 25 miles per hour on a highway segment within the boundaries of a residential subdivision, including a condominium subdivision, consisting of a system of interconnected highways with no through highways and a limited number of dedicated highways that serve as entrances to and exits from the subdivision.*
- **257.671 Designation of through highways; designation of stop, yield, or merge intersections; stop, yield, or merge signs; violation as civil infraction.**
 - *(1) The state highway commission with respect to highways under its jurisdiction, the county road commission, and local authorities with reference to other highways under their jurisdiction, subject to the approval of the state highway commission if a state trunk line highway, may designate through highways and erect stop, yield, or merge signs at specified entrances thereto or may designate any intersection as a stop, yield, or merge intersection and erect like signs at 1 or more entrances to the intersections.*
 - *(2) Every stop, yield, or merge sign shall be reflectorized or illuminated at night. Every stop, yield, or merge sign shall be located as near as practicable at the nearest line of the crosswalk thereat, or, if none, at the nearest line of the roadway.*
- N. 1st Street currently does not have posted speed limit signs, however; there are two (2) posted stop signs currently in place:
 - N. 1st Street at Cedar Street
 - N. 1st Street at W Main Street

EQUIPMENT REQUESTED

- 25 MPH speed limit signs to be placed at the beginning of each direction of N. 1st Street between State Street and Chestnut Street.

BUDGET

- Four 25 MPH speed limit signs with posts, utilizing current supplies and stock

SUBJECT: CONSIDER AUTHORIZING A PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$124,495.50 TO ROTONDO CONSTRUCTION FOR SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE AND FIRE HALL ENTRANCE PAD REPLACEMENT WITH A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF \$124,495.50 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FUND BALANCE.

ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

At the February 18, 2021 City Council meeting, Staff informed Council that our sidewalk maintenance contractor for the last two years, Rotondo Construction, would again hold their 2019 pricing for the upcoming 2021 construction season. Rotondo also informed City staff that if approved, they would begin the season in Brighton prior to starting work in another municipality. If Council agrees to continue using their services for this year, it would enable the City to get an early start on the sidewalk maintenance program without the fear of a late start and running into issues with a new contractor not being able to start work in the City until fall or even next spring.

Last spring, Council considered the first extension of Rotondo's 2019 sidewalk maintenance contract at the May 21, 2020 meeting. Following a discussion regarding this request, City Council voted unanimously to approve the extension. As a result, a budget amendment was done to the 2019/2020 budget, with the same amount being reduced from the 2020/2021 budget. This year, when staff brought the latest extension consideration request to Council at the February 18, 2021 meeting, members expressed they would prefer to have the funds available in the current year budget rather than ask for funds intended for the next year's budget, but would consider the extension when more information would be available.

Last year, sidewalk maintenance work was focused on the south side of the City due to the large number of sidewalk flags that needed attention. While there are still locations that could be addressed in the southern part of the City, staff believes that each area should get an opportunity for the improvement it needs. This year, we are hoping to address the east/north side of Grand River and areas in the northeast quadrant of the City including sidewalk areas that residents have brought to staff's attention over the past year. While it will take staff some time to determine all locations for sidewalk replacement, many areas have already been identified. Staff will have the remaining locations ready before the contractor begins if the extension is approved.

Additionally, the Brighton Area Fire Authority Chief, Michael O'Brien, contacted the City regarding the condition of the concrete entrance pad in front of Station #31 on Grand River. As Council is aware, this building and property is owned and maintained by the City of Brighton. The DPS Director and DPW Superintendent visited the site with Chief O'Brien and confirmed that the area is in very poor condition and needs to be replaced. The Fire Chief's primary concern is that the pad has deteriorated to the point where continued use could potentially damage fire equipment as pieces have broken off. Staff received a quote from Rotondo and they have agreed to hold their pricing for this year. Photographs of the area are attached.

In order to complete the work discussed, staff is requesting Council authorize a purchase order and a budget amendment of \$124,495.50 from the General Fund fund balance to the Major and Local Street Funds and the General Fund. \$90,000 will be allocated for sidewalk maintenance with the remaining \$31,495.50 being used for Fire Hall #31 entrance pad replacement.

Backfilling and restoration will be at the responsibility of Property Owner or Builder, their agent, or their representative. The area where the work is to be done must be accessible to the trucks in order to deliver and install our materials and concrete by the chutes attached to the trucks. Any hazardous or contaminated material encountered on the project is and will remain the property of the owner. All material is guaranteed to be as specified. All work is to be completed according to ACI standard practices. Concrete may crack due to curing or winter frost heaving and is excluded from any coverage.

Any alteration or deviation from the above specifications will involve extra cost and will become an extra charge over and above the estimate. All agreements are contingent upon strikes, accidents, or delays beyond our control. Owner responsible for fire, tornado, and other necessary insurances. Our workers are fully covered by Workman’s Compensation Insurance. Payment is due in full when new concrete is in place. This agreement, as it may be amended from time to time, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the substantive and procedural laws of the State of Michigan without giving effect to the principles of conflict of laws. SUBJECT **CONSIDER AWARD OF BID FOR THE NORTHWEST NEIGHBORHOOD STREET AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO DUNIGAN BROS. INC. FOR \$6,656,722.37, INCLUDING A 15 PERCENT CONTINGENCY, FOR A TOTAL OF \$7,655,230.**

BACKGROUND

For the past several years, preparations have taken place to get the Northwest Neighborhood ready for street reconstruction. Council and Staff have worked together with the residents and engineers to come up with the funding and design needed to bring the streets and infrastructure up to a new standard for the neighborhood. With the passing of the Local Streets Millage in 2019 and the bonding that has now been obtained, the time for the Northwest Neighborhood Street Reconstruction has arrived. The project will include complete street surface restoration with a curb and gutter storm drainage system, new sidewalk, along with replacing the existing 1939 water distribution and sanitary collection systems. The project is scheduled to take three years and be done in three phases, one phase per year.

ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

The first phase will begin at North 7th Street, and stop short of North 4th Street, but will include sections of State and Chestnut Streets. Phase 2 will pick up at North 4th Street and move east across the railroad tracks towards North 2nd Street and will include sections of State, Walnut, Chestnut, North Third and Center Streets. This phase is anticipated to require more attention as there are some obstacles that could affect its progress; namely, the water main crossing at the CSX Railroad and the higher traffic count that is normally seen in this area. Phase 3 will be the last to be completed as the remaining work will be on the east side of North 2nd street, which includes Chestnut, Walnut, and North 1st Streets.

As discussions were held among City Staff and the engineers, the choice was made to bid out all phases as one project using one contractor instead of bidding each phase separately each year. Staff's decision was supported by several reasons. The first was to gain economy of scale if possible. Having one contractor could help prepare for all three years in advance and possibly create savings on materials over the course of the project. Secondly, using the same contractor could limit inconsistencies from one phase to another, which also lessens the issue of determining responsibility if warranty issues develop. And finally, having one contractor can help staff familiarize themselves with the contractor's methods and work behavior making it easier to express and carry out the City's expectations throughout the project. Not to mention developing a rapport can be beneficial for all involved when working with residents on unexpected changes.

With the design engineering being completed earlier this year, bidding was the next step to take place. Due to the size of the project and before the bid documents were available, staff and the engineer

decided that pre-qualifying contractors would be a good idea to reduce potential issues that could come from a less seasoned contractor. Tetra Tech put together pre-qualification documents that required each contractor to supply information that they felt necessary to demonstrate their ability and skill set. Once these documents were developed and after bidding documents became available, a date was set for contractors to submit their qualifications. In total, seven contractors submitted qualification statements on March 9, 2021. After reviewing the qualification statements, six contractors were found acceptable with one being disqualified. On Tuesday April 6, 2021, the City held the bid opening for the project with all six pre-qualified contractors submitting a bid.

As seen above, Dunigan Bros. Inc. of Jackson, Michigan was the low bidder. The City has previously used their services on the 2019 Rickett Road Phase 1 Project and found them to be a reputable and conscientious contractor. While there were some timing issues with that project, they were due to weather and not due to issues with their service. Additionally, references were contacted through the pre-qualification process and found to be favorable.

Funding for this project will come from the Local Streets and Utilities Funds via the Local Streets Millage and bond proceeds. While staff is confident in the contractors bid, unforeseen obstacles may arise over the timeframe of the project. Tetra Tech's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) was comparable at \$7,751,434. While their project estimate did not include a contingency, staff and the engineer feel that a 15 percent contingency would be warranted for the project due to its size and duration.

On behalf of the City of Brighton, bids were received for the Northwest Neighborhood 2020 Street Improvements, Contract 12766-16002-RSW-1, on Tuesday, April 6, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. Six (6) bids were presented and publicly read via Zoom video conferencing. The project is based on unit prices with lump sum pricing for certain line items. The bid tabulations are split by phases with Phase 1 anticipated for completion in the 2021 construction season, Phase 2 in year 2022, and Phase 3 in year 2023.

Tetra Tech assisted the City in prequalifying bidders prior to the bid opening. Tetra Tech reviewed bidder’s qualification statements using a standardized review worksheet to produce a prequalification score and checked bidder references. The results of the prequalification process were provided in the Tetra Tech letter dated March 12, 2021 entitled “Contractor Prequalification” for the City’s use in accessing the bidder prequalifications. Six (6) contractors were approved by the City to bid Northwest Neighborhood 2020 Street Improvements.

We have reviewed the provided “Bid Unit Price” with the “Bid Price” for all Contractor bids received. The below tables compare Bid Price from the Contractor’s Bid Form to the calculated Extended Bid Price. The Extended Bid Price, as defined in the bidding documents, is the Contractor’s Unit Price bid multiplied by the Estimated Quantity listed on the Bid Form. The Extended Bid Price Tables are included as an attachment for the City’s reference and files. In cases of discrepancies, the Extended Bid Price is prevalent. The following table summarizes the extended bid price findings.

Dunigan Bros. was the apparent low bidder with a base bid of \$6,656,722.37. Tetra Tech and the City have successfully worked with this Contractor on the North Rickett Road Sanitary Sewer and Road Improvement project. Dunigan Bros. was prequalified by the City to bid on the project and Tetra Tech has no major indicators that lead Tetra Tech to believe that Dunigan Bros. will not be a responsive contractor.

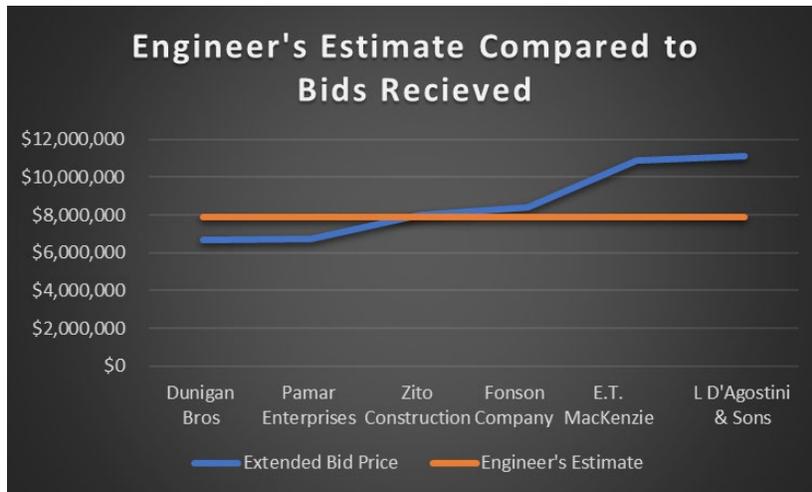
The below table compares the Engineer’s OPCC to the low bidder’s proposal. Details of the Engineer’s OPCC is in the attached Bid Tabulation.

As shown above Dunigan Bros. bid is below the Engineer’s estimate by approximately \$1.09 million dollars. However, the Engineer’s OPCC of \$7,751,434.00 was within the range of bids received from all prospective bidders. It should be the two lowest bidders are within \$92,082.79 of each other, which is an indicator that the low bid is reasonably and in-line with the bids received.

The below figure is a graphic illustration of the bid prices compared to the Engineer’s Estimate. As indicated, two (2) bids were below and four (4) bids were above the Engineer’s Estimate.



After reviewing the bids received, we recommend the City accept the bid from Dunigan Bros. based on the unit prices presented which, when applied to the estimated quantities of work, yields a corrected bid amount of \$6,656,722.37.

Tetra Tech further recommends the City include a construction contingency within the range of 10% to 15%. The construction contingency would be used to cover variable construction costs including, but not limited to, unforeseen site conditions, change orders, errors/omissions and field modifications over the entirety of the construction phase.

The attached Contractor Notice of Award should be signed by the City after City Council has approved the contractor's bid. The Contractor Notice of Award notifies the bidder of the City's intent to enter into a contract for the work and initiates the Contractor to obtain the required insurance and bonding documentation. We further recommend the City authorize the signing of the Agreement once the required insurance and bonding documentation is received.

Once the contract documents are fully executed, we will schedule a preconstruction meeting with Dunigan Bros. and City staff to initiate the construction phase of the work. We look forward to working with Dunigan Bros. and the City in the completion of this important project.

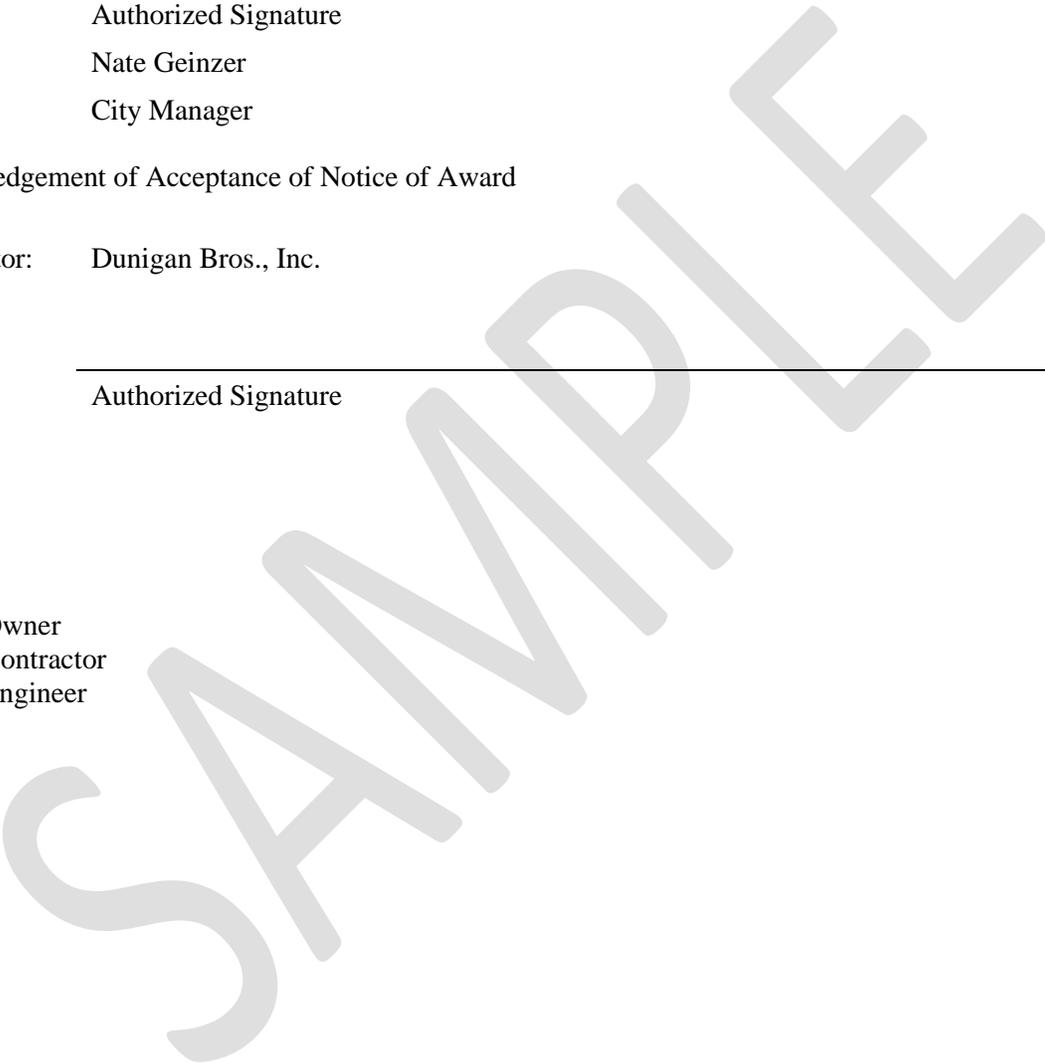

SUBJECT: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF FIVE CIVIC EVENT APPLICATIONS

ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

- As staff noted at the April 1, 2021 Council meeting, civic event applicants who may have wanted to take advantage of the approval of a possible Social District by City Council, were allowed to submit applications past the original March 1 deadline in anticipation of this ordinance becoming effective. However, Staff has since determined that the Social Districts discussion will not be reviewed by City Council until later in the year. Staff has contacted those applicants and advised them to submit their applications without the social district option, noting that if the issue were approved later, they would be able to revise their application, if they desired.
- Four applications were received as a result. They are A Taste of Brighton, Brighton's Smokin' Jazz & BBQ Blues Festival, W.A.M. Festival, and Ladies Night Out.
- Additionally, another application was received during this time, which is a new event and was not included in the applications that were waiting for the Social District decision. It is The Brighton High School Formal Night. This event would allow the Brighton High School Seniors the ability to dine at downtown restaurants, take photographs with each other and their parents, and gather while allowing for social distancing. They are proposing to close Main Street from 4 pm to 10 pm on Wednesday, June 2. This event is still in the planning stages and Staff will be working with the High School on more details of the event.
- Any outstanding items (such as insurance requirements, signatures needed, event maps, event details, etc.) that are required for each event will be obtained prior to the start of the events. All five of these events will require at least one pre-event meeting to discuss the details of the events and what assistance is needed from the DPW, Police Department, and Brighton Area Fire Authority.
- All applicants will be advised that they will need to adhere to all Federal, State and Local orders regarding participant limitations, social distancing, mask wearing, etc. in effect at the time of the event. In addition, if their event is anticipated to draw more people than the limits, the event will not be able to occur.
