MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BRIGHTON CITY COUNCIL HELD ON MAY 12, 2018

1. Call to Order

Mayor Muzzin called the Special Meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

2. Roll Call

Present were Mayor Muzzin, Mayor Pro-Tem Pipoly, Councilmembers: Emaus, Gardner, Pettengill and Tobbe. Absent was Councilmember Bohn. Staff: City Clerk Tara Brown, Assistant to the City Manager/DDA Coordinator Brandon Skopek, DPW Director Marcel Goch, Police Chief Robert Bradford, and Attorney Brad Maynes. There was no one in the audience.

Motion by Mayor Pro Tem Pipoly, second by Councilmember Emaus, to excuse Councilmember Bohn from this morning's meeting for personal reasons. **The motion carried unanimously**

3. Call to Public

Mayor Muzzin opened the Call to the Public at 8:01 p.m. with no response.

4. Affirm Ballot Language for the August 7, 2018 Headlee Override Proposal

Attorney Brad Maynes gave an overview of the ballot language and the difference between the original ballot language that was submitted and the change to add the ten-year sunset provision. Attorney Maynes explained that the County Clerk had approved this language previously. Mayor Muzzin and Councilmember Gardner asked about the question mark in the ballot language, Attorney Maynes clarified that it is standard.

Motion by Mayor Pro Tem Pipoly, second by Councilmember Gardner, to approve the Ballot Language for the August 7, 2018 Headlee Override Proposal. **There was a roll call vote. Yes: Emaus, Gardner, Muzzin, Pettengill, and Pipoly. No: Tobbe. Absent: Bohn. The motion passed 5-1-1.**
